General Information

Due to the large numbers attending, we ask that **pupils are accompanied by one parent only**, including on the Familiarisation Afternoon.

On the morning of each of the tests, pupils should bring the following:

- **The SEAG Pupil Card (printed out)**
- **The Friends' School Registration Card (will receive on Familiarisation)**

In line with SEAG guidance, the following are **not** permitted: watches, mobile phones, food/drink and pencil cases. Pupils are encouraged to wear their school uniform.

Pencils and rubbers will be provided for each pupil. Water will also be available in each room. If pupils wish to use a highlighter they may bring this with them.

Some parking will be available on-site; alternatively, you may use on-street parking and walk to school. **Please note that traffic wardens will issue tickets to cars parked on yellow lines or inside the bus stop markings outside school.**

Test Saturdays

The tests take place on 15 and 22 November 2025. On test mornings, please arrive at the Assembly Hall between 9.15 and 9.30am.

At **9.35am** pupils will make their way to their examination room. Staff and prefects will accompany them and help them find their allocated seat. They will be in the same seat for both the tests. As far as possible we have arranged for pupils to be seated in an assessment room with other pupils from their primary school.

The test takes place between 10.00am and 11.15am.

Test Period (Parents)

When the children have been dropped off, parents should, where possible leave the school site. Alternatively, if you have parked on-site you may remain in your vehicle, but please keep noise to a minimum so that the children are not disturbed while they are doing the test. The school gates will be locked during this time. Once the test is over, pupils will be brought back to their pick-up point. Parents are asked to meet them here or at a pre-arranged meeting point. The school gates will be opened at 11.15am.

Access Arrangements

Those with extra time under Access Arrangements will follow the same procedures as above but will be together in a separate classroom and will finish at approximately 11.30am.
