Art	N/A	Continuous Assessment of the Pop Art Project	The Winter Assessment mark is a product of all the Ceramic project work.
Biology	45	Short questions	Microbiology topic; Microorganisms and Pathogens, Aseptic techniques, Barriers to infection, Primary and secondary response to infection, Vaccinations, Antibiotics, Practical work, Non-communicable disease.
Chemistry	45	Short questions	Acids and Alkalis Learn safety rules, pH scale, indicators, and acid/alkali properties. Explore reactions with metals and carbonates, gas tests, and salt formation. Understand acid rain causes and how it can be prevented.
English	60	Short questions followed by an extended essay on their class novel	Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar revision from weekly 10-minute tests. Key scenes linked to the theme of violence for Lord of the Flies.
