- If you wish to study in school, the library is available for revision. However, you may also be directed to the Assembly Hall for revision between exams.
- All exams begin at the start of the session. Please arrive promptly for all your exams.
- You may use the Assembly Hall at break time.
- Lunch is available every day in the Dining Hall.
- If an exam is scheduled for two or more rooms the classes assigned to each room will be posted outside Private Study, the Gym and on the pupil noticeboard the morning of the exam.
- Mr. Cunningham will confirm any access arrangements that have been put in place (extra time, etc.) before the exam period begins.
- All mobile devices and smart watches should be turned off and left in your schoolbag.
- Schoolbags should be safely stored before entering large exam rooms such as the Gym and Private Study, or left at the front when taking exams in smaller rooms.
- Only see-through pencil cases are permitted on desks.

Exam Clashes and Missed Exams:

If you miss an exam or experience a scheduling clash, you should sit the affected paper during the next available exam session that you can attend. In the event of a clash, please sit the longest exam in the correct slot.

When catching up on **missed** exams:

- Report to the Gym for AM1 and AM2 sessions.
- Attend Private Study (PS) for PM sessions, which begin at 1:15pm.
