Subject	Length (mins)	Format	Topics
<b>Art</b>	30	Short essay question - critical analysis	Year 8 Colour Theory Knowledge Organiser. Practical work will also be assessed for the Winter Exams.
<b>English</b>	45	Comprehension	Chapters 1-11 of Goodnight Mister Tom, focusing on the character of Willie.
<b>Geography</b>	45	Short questions	Introduction to Geography and Rivers.
<b>French</b>	25 Reading 25 Writing	Reading comprehension and writing tasks including single words and longer sentences	Vocabulary recognition and spelling of units 1+2 and part of 3 plus days of week, months, dates. Answer questions about yourself, family and where you live.
<b>HE</b>	45	Short questions	Washing up; equipment; cooker; food preparation methods; weighing and measuring; hygiene; and first aid.
<b>History</b>	60	Short questions, sources	Foundations of History, Foundation of Rome, Punic Wars, Army.
<b>IT</b>	45	Short questions	ESafety (Screentime); Input-Process-Output; Desktop publishing; Computer Hardware; Bits and Bytes; Binary/Decimal conversion.
<b>Junior Science</b>	45	Short questions, factual recall, 1/2 longer answer questions, graph work.	Being a Scientist, Life the Body Systems and Cells. A revision list will be given out in class.
<b>Mathematics</b>	45	Non-Calculator	Topics 1-5 in Year 8 topic list. Revision resources - Dr Frost Maths, Corbettmaths, Key Stage 3 Google site.
<b>Music</b>	45	Short questions	The Orchestra, Notation, Elements of Music Keyboard performance (30%), Listening test (30%).
<b>RS</b>	45	Short questions	Topics from this term.
<b>Technology</b>	45	Short questions	Safety, Plastics, Working with plastics, Graphics (All content in booklet 1 and in graphics booklet).
